

**MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF
NATIONAL COMPANY LAW TRIBUNAL BAR ASSOCIATION**

1. NAME:

The name of the Society shall be “**NATIONAL COMPANY LAW TRIBUNAL BAR ASSOCIATION**” (hereinafter referred to as “the Society”).

2. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The Registered Office of the Society shall remain in the National Capital Territory of Delhi and at present is situated at E-2, Kailash Colony, New Delhi – 110 048.

3. AIMS & OBJECTS:

The aims and objects for which the Society has been established are as under:

- (a) To undertake the task of professional development and to give the members, professional, financial, legal or social support and to extend helping hand to them to maintain their dignity, professional independence and to keep and maintain the high standard of dignity of the profession in the eyes of the Corporate Management, Government, Professionals and the public in general and render all possible assistance, support and co-operation to the members, which otherwise is not made available or cannot be extended to the members, particularly the activities and facilities in the nature of WELFARE, RECREATIONAL, ASSISTANCE in the nature of financial or otherwise, HELP or AID to the individual member or his family in the hour of need.
- (b) To undertake the tasks, works, assignments, activities, services, facilities etc., to provide, arrange, manage, control, take over or acquire at its own or in agreement, arrangement, collaboration with any body corporate, firm, Society, club or individual, to provide any kind of aid, help, assistance, facility in the form of financial, social, moral, legal or professional to the members and to their families.
- (c) To create an atmosphere of brotherhood in the profession, members and their families and also with the brethren of other professions.
- (d) To extend friendly and supporting hand to the members and their families, especially when they are in distress, in the nature of financial, social, moral, professional or otherwise, as may be decided by the Society from time to time, keeping in view the merits of each case.
- (e) To arrange, manage, take over, control or provide services or facilities in the nature of professional development, social, recreational, exchange of views by organising visits or tours of members and their families to the various cities/regions/countries and to undertake the task of national integration.
- (f) To open the branches, regional or zonal offices of the Society to propagate the objects of the Society.
- (g) To undertake the cultural, social, educational, professional, recreational, religious, welfare, moral and spiritual and such other activity as are conducive to the development of intellectual, spiritual and creative faculties of its members and their families/guests, including opening of clubs, Holiday Homes, Guest Houses, Nursing Homes, Dispensaries,

Training Centre, Vocational Guidance Centres, Coffee Houses, Cafeterias, Canteens, Auditoriums, Exhibitions, Emporiums, Libraries, Community Centres, information Centres or any other thing as may be decided by the Society.

- (h) To organise charity shows, film shows, variety programmes, premiers, star-nites, social, religious, spiritual or professional gatherings, seminars, meets, debates, etc., or to do any other thing for the benefit of the members, their families.
- (i) To publish magazines, periodicals, News Letters, Souvenirs or to make short films, plays, film serials or feature films.
- (j) To acquire, purchase, takeover, take on rent, lease, licence or possession of any movable or immovable property in the form of land, building, means of transport such as car, bus, coach, van, boat, etc., or any other property and to raise construction of structure thereon or to make that property usable for the purposes of the Society in any manner, whatsoever.
- (k) To do any other work, task or undertake any other activity, service, facility or any other thing which may lawfully and legally be done or under taken by the Society and is covered by the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi.
- (l) The Society shall be a non-political organisation.
- (m) The Society may raise its funds by way of receiving admission fee, subscription, donations, grants, subsidies, assistance, advertisements, help or aid from the members, the organisations, firms, bodies corporate, societies, clubs, individuals or from any other person, local bodies, statutory bodies, governments etc., and the incomes received from the various kinds of services or facilities provided or arranged or managed by the Society or from any other source, which should of course be legal one.
- (n) All the incomes, earnings, movable and immovable properties of the Society shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Society or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

4. GOVERNING COUNCIL:
